He moved to Tokyo in 1997 as a Professor of the Medical Research Institute of Tokyo Medical and Dental University and decided to try deciphering the splicing code to cure some genetic diseases caused by aberrant splicing. He moved to Kyoto University in 2010 as Professor of the Department of Anatomy and Developmental Biology in the Graduate School of Medicine. He is now Professor and Chairman of Department of Drug Discovery Medicine and Director of Medical Research Support Center.
