

Fátima Gebauer received her PhD in 1990 from the Autónoma University of Madrid and performed postdocs in the labs of Joel Richter (UMAss, USA) and Matthias Hentze (EMBL, Germany). In 2000, she obtained a staff scientist position at EMBL, and in 2002 an independent position at the CRG (Barcelona, Spain), where she is Senior Group Leader and Co-coordinator of the Genome Biology Program. Fátima is EMBO member, member of Academia Europaea, Associate editor of the RNA Journal, President of the RNA Society and Vicepresident of the European network Translacore. Research in her lab centers on RNA-binding proteins and mechanisms of translational control in human cancer (mostly melanoma). Approaches include high-throughput methods (iCLIP, RNA-Seq, polysome-Seq, RIC, proteomics), biochemistry and pre-clinical models.
