

Prof. Aron Popovtzer

Prof. Aron Popovtzer is Director of the Sharett Oncology Institute at Hadassah Medical Center. He is a graduate of the Hadassah–Hebrew University School of Medicine and completed his internship and residency in Otolaryngology (ENT) at Beilinson Hospital (Rabin Medical Center). Prof. Popovtzer later completed a double residency in oncology and radiotherapy and has been a board-certified expert in both fields since 2009.

He specialized in head and neck cancer at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor and completed advanced training in brachytherapy at Beth Israel Hospital in New York, as well as radiosurgery training at Memorial Hospital in New York, with a focus on targeted spinal radiation and thyroid cancer. His clinical expertise includes personalized medicine, immunotherapy and biological treatments, radio surgery, acoustic neurinoma, recurrent head and neck cancers, and tumors with spinal metastases.

Prof. Popovtzer serves as Chairman of the Israeli Society for Head and Neck Tumors, Israel's representative to the World Society for Head and Neck Cancer and is an active member of the European Organization for Research and Treatment of Cancer (EORTC). He is also a senior lecturer at Tel Aviv University and has received multiple awards for his contributions to the scientific community.
