



**Claudio Sette** is an Associate Professor of Anatomy in the Department of Public Health and Cell Biology at the School of Medicine, University of Rome Tor Vergata. He has held this position since 2002 and currently serves within the Department of Biomedicine and Prevention. He is also jointly appointed as Laboratory Director at the Institute for Experimental Neurosciences of the Fondazione Santa Lucia in Rome.
