



Carsten Müller-Tidow is Professor of Medicine at Heidelberg University and Director of the Department of Hematology, Oncology and Rheumatology at Heidelberg University Hospital. He is co-Director of the Molecular Medicine partnership unit (MMPU) EMBL-UKHD Heidelberg and he is speaker of the Heidelberg Gene and Cell Therapy Center. He studied medicine in Aachen, Bonn and the United States. He did Residency and Fellowship in Internal Medicine and Hematology and Oncology. For three years he was a research fellow at UCLA School of Medicine in Los Angeles. In 2009 he was appointed full Professor for Hematology and Oncology in Münster, Germany. In 2014 he became Director of the Department of Medicine IV and of the State Center for Cell and Gene Therapy at Halle (Saale) University Hospital. Since 2017 he works as Professor at Heidelberg University Hospital. His research interests focus on non-coding RNA functions in hematological malignancies.
